**Early Bed Down** *Please be respectful of stalling arrangements. SPACE IS LIMITED*

**Cattle Arrival** *Please be respectful of stalling arrangements. SPACE IS LIMITED*

- Cattle may arrive beginning Sunday, March 28, 2021

## **Trailer Arrival**

- **Please ENTER and EXIT Pickaway County Fairgrounds off of \*\*\*Stoutsville Pike**
  - As you head east on SR 22 off of U.S. 23, go past the main fair entrance (a large cow is above the sign)
  - Head straight to the next road on the right. Entrance is on the right.
  - A show staff member will be at the gate to tell you which facility entrance gate to proceed too. They will send you to the gate closest to your barn to unload.
  - ***Gates will be identified for enter and exit purposes. Please adhere!***

## **Dismissed**

- All livestock are permitted to leave after they show

## **Milking Parlor**

- The facility does **not** have a Milking Parlor, but portable pumps and buckets will be available for use.
- Milk will be disposed of in specific locations! **Do not dump milk in drains!** Ask if you need assistance.

## **Stalling/Barn Space**

- Stalling is assigned based on the number of head entered.
- ***Limited space will be available for exhibitors to store feed and supplies.*** There will be space but not for HUGE amounts of feed and hay. The parking lot is very close to the barns for close storage of extra supplies. We also encourage exhibitors to bring tarps to cover extra hay if being stored outside of barns. There is plenty of outdoor area for hay storage along the barns. Please bring tarps in case of rain.
- Pipe Gates will be the method of Tie-Rail

## **Health Guidelines - Humans**

- Due to the fluid scenarios of the state we will do our best to keep you informed of the most current expectations.
- **Please wear masks when inside buildings.**
- Remember 6 ft social distancing guidelines and do not eat in the barns.

### Health Guidelines - Cows

- OUT OF STATE CATTLE must have a health paper with permanent ID and proper testing to come into the state of Ohio. Please check with your vet.

### Milk Sampling/Ultrasound

- Milk samples and Ultrasound will be utilized

### Power

- There are many electric outlets throughout the facility, but if you plan on many fans and other items requiring power, it is advisable to *bring your own portable generator* for backup. DO NOT PLACE DIRECTLY on the asphalt.

### Tents

- **NO tents/huts may be inside the barns due to space and COVID-19 guidelines.** Tents may be used outside of the barns. Pop-up tents and canopies are also encouraged for outside fitting and prep use.
- ***NO stakes can be used to anchor tent legs.*** Please find other ways to secure so as not to damage Fairground driveways or buildings.
- We encourage exhibitors to make “living space” outside the barn under pop-up tents. Groups of family/herd units are permitted.
- **Please remember to practice 6 ft social distancing at all times.**

### Check-in

- Exhibitors will bring registration papers to the check in area.
- Registration papers will be kept until the conclusion of the breed show.
- Breed reps will be responsible for animal verification and show ring procedures.

### Camping - Please pre-arrange camping with the Pickaway County Ag Society

- ***PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.***

- ***LIMITED Hay, Straw, Shavings and Feed might be available at the show.*** If you would like bedding and feed supplies - ***please PRE-ORDER PRIOR.***

### Food *(Do not eat in barns, in compliance with health codes of Pickaway County. Tables will be available in designated areas)*
